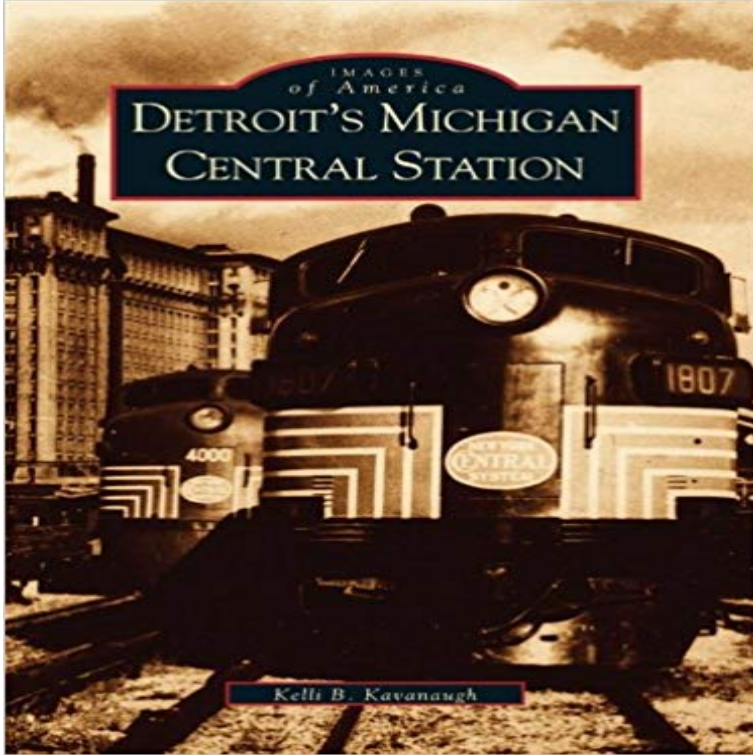


Detroit's Michigan Central Station (Images of America)
