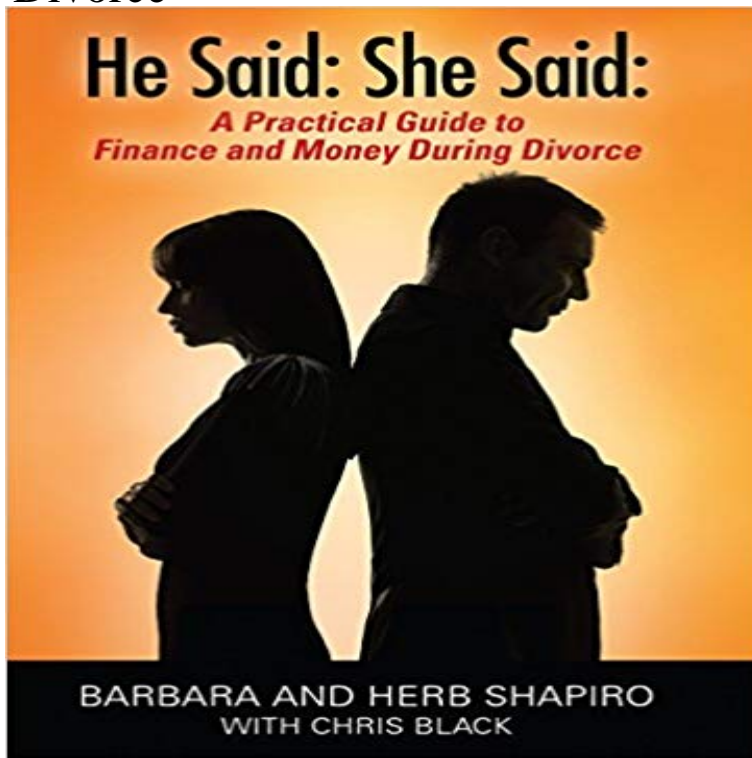


He Said: She Said: A Practical Guide to Finance and Money During Divorce
