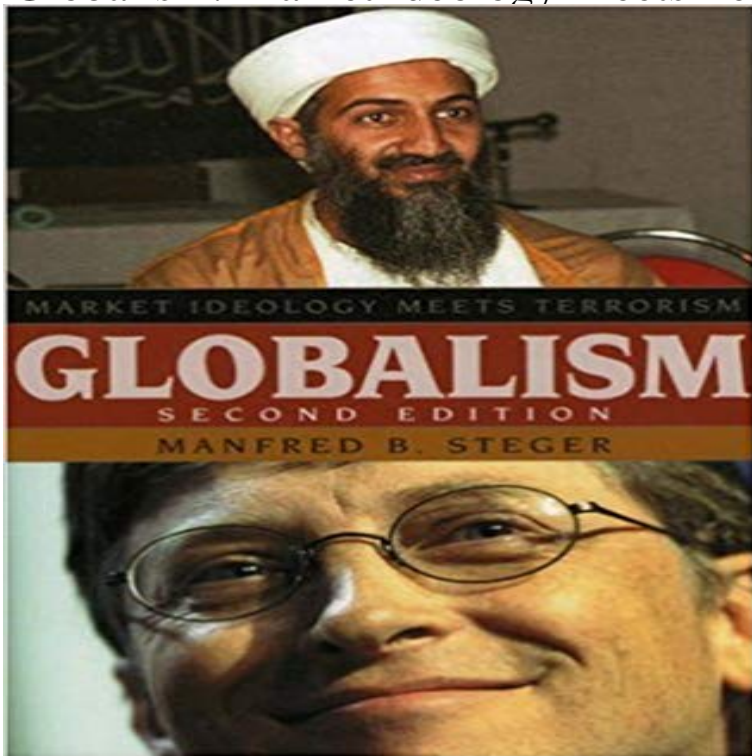


# Globalism: Market Ideology Meets Terrorism (Globalization)
